- Open entry qualifications recognised by the Ministry of Higher Education, Malaysia:
 - Be at least 21 years old and possess PMR or its equivalent, OR
- Other qualifications recognised by AeU Senate.

1. **When are the intakes?**
 - January, May and September.
 2. **How do you apply?**
