Bachelor of Information & Communication Technology (Hons.)

- ◆ This program offers the relevant IT knowledge sufficient to fulfil the needs of today's industry.
- ◆ Suitable for both people looking for intermediate knowledge in IT as well as those people looking for hard-core IT knowledge.
- ◆ The program is arranged in a way that the core courses will equip students with fundamental to intermediate IT knowledge. Bachelor programme
